BA (HONS) FASHION

This course has a reputation for the excellence of fashion graduates it produces consistently year after year. Through helping students develop creativity and originality along with professional skills, the course also helps in the development of a high level of interpersonal skills through a personal programme of study with tutors and industry practitioners.

The syllabus focuses on research, the development of ideas, pattern cutting, garment construction. Students are encouraged to explore their own personal design philosophy and identity, and to acquire an understanding of the design process and how it operates within the fashion industry.

BA (HONS) **FASHION DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY**

This course has been designed to produce graduates with the highly desirable combination of creative flair and technical competence. This is achieved throughout the course by developing both a creative ability and a thorough knowledge of technological and business applications.

This course is delivered jointly by the Faculty of Art & Design and the Department of Clothing Design & Technology and benefits from specialist knowledge in both areas. This course provides a unique approach to creative fashion design, which emphasises the enhancement of creativity and commercial credibility achieved through the applications of appropriate technology.

BA (HONS) EMBROIDERY

This is the only full-time embroidery degree in the UK, and is renowned for the quality of its graduates. The course fosters a professional attitude in all areas, offering a diverse programme of visual research and projects exploring embroidery in a broad context to develop students' creative potential. Students eventually decide their own course content, adding independence and initiative to the other qualities they gain.

BA (HONS) **TEXTILES**

This course produces individual designers or craftspeople with high creativity, underpinned with technical and interpersonal skills. Painting and drawing is strongly emphasised throughout the course, which includes opportunities to work in the areas of knitted, printed and woven textiles. Optional projects are available throughout the course. For example, students can spend time in the fashion or embroidery areas, or even in other specialist areas within the Faculty of Art & Design.
