DYSLEXIA / DISABILITY

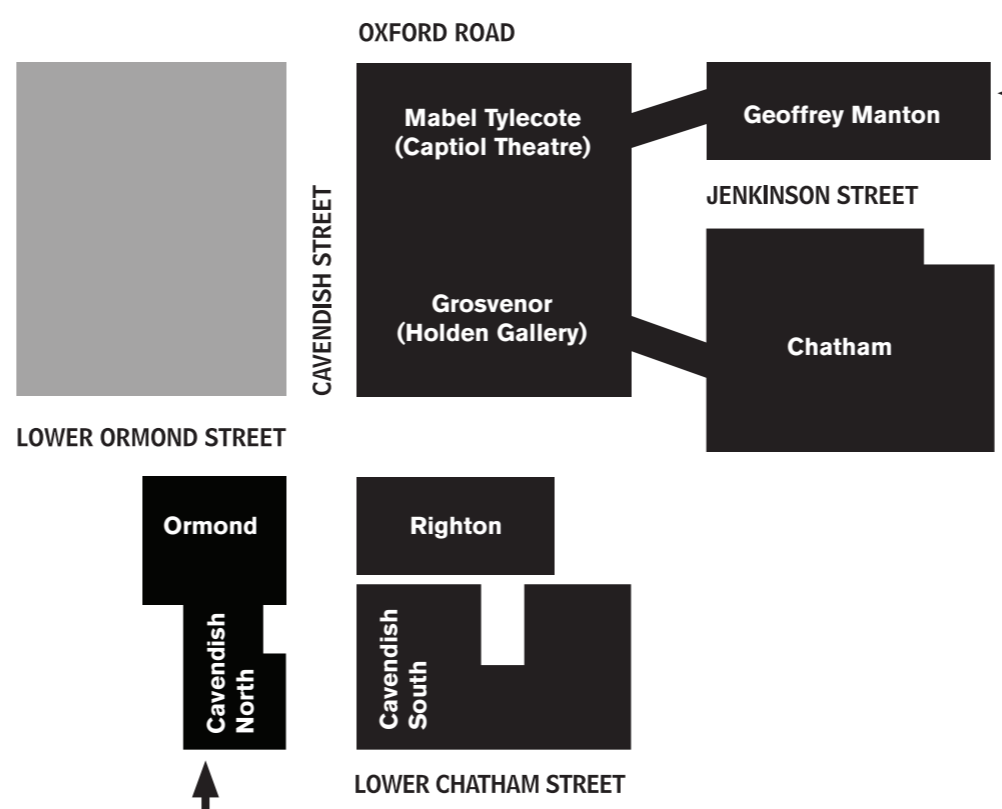
